AN ACT Relating to Additional Appeals Under Liquor Laws.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 28, § 403, amended. The first sentence of section 403 of Title 28 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

If any person is aggrieved by the decision of the commission in revoking or suspending any license issued by the commission or by refusal of the commission to issue any license applied for, he may within 30 days thereafter appeal to the Superior Court ~~by filing a complaint therefor~~ **and such appeal shall be confined to the record.**
