AN ACT Relating to Importation of Bottled Wines by Licensed Maine Bottlers.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 28, § 501, amended. Section 501 of Title 28 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by section 2 of chapter 149 of the public laws of 1965, is further amended by adding at the end the following paragraph:

Licensed Maine wine bottlers and wineries are authorized to sell to the commission, to purchasers outside of the State, and to any instrumentality of the United States, wines imported into the State in sealed bottles upon the express condition that the importation of said wine in sealed bottles is authorized by the commission.
