STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-SEVEN

RESOLVE, Providing Funds for Fisheries Instruction and Literature Publication and Dissemination.

Funds for fisheries education. Resolved: That there is appropriated to the Department of Sea and Shore Fisheries the sum of \$11,450 from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund, said amount to be matched by Federal-State Technical Services Act of 1965 (P. L. 89-182) funds in the amount of \$11,450 for the purpose of reprinting department publications, printing new publications and maintaining a mailing list and distributing such publications, and for providing a series of lectures and demonstrations on shrimp fishing, demonstrations of the use of compressed air in ice control of rivers, harbors and pounds, a 10-hour course in seafood handling to be offered at 3 coastal locations, and a demonstration of electrolysis and methods of control for fishing boats. The breakdown shall be as follows:

Any unexpended balance shall not lapse but shall remain a continuing carrying account until June 30, 1969.
