STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Increasing Size of Maine Real Estate Commission.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 32, § 4051, amended. The first 3 sentences of section 4051 of Title 32 of the Revised Statutes are amended to read as follows:

The Maine Real Estate Commission, as hertofore established and in this chapter called the "commission," shall consist of 35 persons appointed by the Governor, each of whom shall be a resident of the State and who, immediately prior to the date of his appointment, shall have been a resident of the State for 5 years and whose vocation for a period of at least 10 years shall have been that of a real estate broker or a real estate salesman. Upon the expiration of the term of office of any member, his successor shall be appointed for a term of 3 years and until his successor is appointed and qualified. There shall at no time be more than one commissioner from any one county, and appointments shall be made resulting in a reasonable distribution of commissioners among the major sections of the State.
