AN ACT Increasing Salaries of Boxing Commissioners.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 8, § 101, amended. The 2nd sentence of section 101 of Title 8 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

Each member of the commission shall receive a salary of ~~\$850~~ \$1,500 a year and his reasonable expenses, including transportation, incurred in the performance of his duties.

Sec. 2. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Maine State Boxing Commission, the sum of \$1,465 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1968 and the sum of \$1,950 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1969, to carry out the purposes of this Act. The breakdown shall be as follows:
