COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 659, L.D. 914, Bill, "An Act
Providing Funds for Residential Facility for Mentally
Retarded Children in Aroostook County."

Amend said Bill by striking out everything after the enacting
clause and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Residential facility for mentally retarded children; funds
for. There is appropriated to the Department of Mental Health
and Corrections from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General
Fund the sum of \$177,500 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1968
for the purpose of building a residential facility in connection
with the day school program currently being operated by the Central
Aroostook Association for the Mentally Retarded.

There is also appropriated to the Department of Mental
Health and Corrections from the General Fund the sum of \$40,000
for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1969 for operating funds for
this facility. The breakdown shall be as follows:
