AN ACT Providing Funds for Residential Facility for Mentally Retarded Children in Aroostook County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Residential facility for mentally retarded children; funds for. There is appropriated to the Department of Mental Health and Corrections from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$177,500 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1968, and from the General Fund the sum of \$40,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1969, to build and operate a residential facility in connection with the day school program currently being operated by the Central Aroostook Association for the Mentally Retarded.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

This residential facility is essential to complete the program initiated by the 102nd Legislature and implemented by local participation. Substantial federal matching funds are available which may lapse on June 30, 1967. Information available with respect to federal funds after the legislative cloture date may substantially alter the money requirements of this legislation.
