IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-SEVEN

AN ACT to Authorize Food Stamp Program in Sagadahoc County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- Sec. 1. Food Stamp Program in Sagadahoc County authorized. The Department of Health and Welfare is authorized to administer in Sagadahoc County a so-called "Food Stamp Program" in cooperation with the United States Department of Agriculture and in accordance with the applicable rules, regulations and policies of that department.
- Sec. 2. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Health and Welfare the sum of \$18,100 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1968 and \$19,200 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1969 to carry out the provisions of this Act. The breakdown of expenditures shall be as follows:
