AN ACT to Authorize Food Stamp Program in Sagadahoc County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. Food Stamp Program in Sagadahoc County authorized. The Department of Health and Welfare is authorized to administer in Sagadahoc County a so-called "Food Stamp Program" in cooperation with the United States Department of Agriculture and in accordance with the applicable rules, regulations and policies of that department.

Sec. 2. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Health and Welfare the sum of \$18,100 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1968 and \$19,200 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1969 to carry out the provisions of this Act. The breakdown of expenditures shall be as follows:
