STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
SIXTY-SEVEN

AN ACT to Change Date of Caucus Election of City of Biddeford.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1933, c. 71, § 2, amended. The last sentence of the first paragraph of section 2 of chapter 71 of the private and special laws of 1933, as repealed and replaced by section 2 of chapter 83 of the private and special laws of 1941 and amended by chapter 124 of the private and special laws of 1957, is further amended to read as follows:

Only those voters enrolled as qualified to vote in such caucuses as hereinafter provided shall participate therein; all nominations by petition or as provided ~~for under section 52 of chapter 4 of the~~ **by the Maine Revised Statutes of 1954** shall be voted upon at the next **biennial** municipal election, and the caucus for such candidates by petition or by said nomination papers shall be held in the several wards of the city on the ~~2nd last~~ **last** Monday of ~~December~~ **November**, ~~in each year~~ **biennially**, on which day the polls will be opened at ~~7~~ **9** o'clock in the ~~afternoon~~ **forenoon** and continue open to 8 o'clock in the evening, when they shall close.
