## STATE OF MAINE

## IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-SEVEN

#### AN ACT to Change Date of Caucus Election of City of Biddeford.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**P. & S. L., 1933, c. 71, § 2, amended.** The last sentence of the first paragraph of section 2 of chapter 71 of the private and special laws of 1933, as repealed and replaced by section 2 of chapter 83 of the private and special laws of 1941 and amended by chapter 124 of the private and special laws of 1957, is further amended to read as follows:

Only those voters enrolled as qualified to vote in such caucuses as hereinafter provided shall participate therein; all nominations by petition or as provided for under section 52 of chapter  $\pm$  of the by the Maine Revised Statutes of 1954 shall be voted upon at the next biennial municipal election, and the caucus for such candidates by petition or by said nomination papers shall be held in the several wards of the city on the 2nd last Monday of December November, in each year biennially, on which day the polls will be opened at  $\pm$  9 o'clock in the afternoon forenoon and continue open to 8 o'clock in the evening, when they shall close.
