## STATE OF MAINE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES 103rd LEGISLATURE

HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 342, L.D. 926, Bill, "An Act Establishing the Policemen's Arbitration Law."

Amend said Bill by inserting after section 7 (same in L.D. 926) a new section, as follows:

'Sec. 7-A. R.S., T. 26, §988, amended. The last sentence of section 988 of Title 26 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by chapter 396 of the public laws of 1965, is amended to read as follows:

A majority decision of the arbitrators shall not be final and binding upon either the bargaining agent or the corporate authorities.'
