HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 342, L.D. 926, Bill, "An Act  
Establishing the Policemen's Arbitration Law."

Amend said Bill by inserting after section 7 (same in L.D.  
926) a new section, as follows:

'Sec. 7-A. R.S., T. 26, §988, amended. The last sentence  
of section 988 of Title 26 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by  
chapter 396 of the public laws of 1965, is amended to read as  
follows:

A majority decision of the arbitrators shall not be final and  
binding upon either the bargaining agent or the corporate authorities.'
