SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 347, L. D. 931, Bill, "An Act Relating to Notice of Legislative Hearings."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of that part designated "~~§4.~~" and inserting in place thereof the following:

§4. Notices of legislative hearings

Notice of hearings on bills and resolves, except for new drafts of the same, to be heard by committees of the Legislature during a regular session after February 15th of any year shall be given by publishing the title of the bill or resolve and the time and place of the hearing in the state paper, and such other newspapers as may be designated by the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives, at least 7 days before the hearing. Failure to give sufficient notice shall not invalidate any action taken by the Legislature.'
