AN ACT Relating to Notice of Legislative Hearings.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 3, § 4, additional. Title 3 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 4 to read as follows:

§ 4. Notices of legislative hearings

Notice of hearings on bills and resolves to be heard by committees of the Legislature shall be given by publishing the title of the bill or resolve and the time and place of the hearing in the state paper, and such other newspapers as may be designated by the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives, at least 7 days before the hearing.
