HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to H.P. 671, L.D. 943, Bill, "An Act  
Relating to Wearing Fluorescent Clothing When Hunting  
in Southwestern Zone for Two Years."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of that part  
designated "§2468." and inserting in place thereof the  
following:

'§2468. Fluorescent clothing

A person, while hunting with firearms in the Southern  
Deer Hunting Zone during the 1967 and 1968 deer hunting  
season, except when hunting waterfowl from a boat or blind,  
shall wear at least a single item of fluorescent orange  
clothing which is visible at a 360° angle.'
