SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 671, L. D. 943, Bill, "An Act Relating to Wearing Fluorescent Clothing When Hunting in Southwestern Zone for Two Years."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the last paragraph and inserting in place thereof the following:

'A person, while hunting with firearms in that area of
the State south of U. S. Route 2 and west of the Kennebec River
during the 1967 and 1968 deer hunting season, except
when hunting waterfowl from a boat or blind, shall wear fluorescent,
orange clothing which is visible from all sides.'
