## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Wearing Fluorescent Clothing When Hunting in Southwestern Zone for Two Years.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 12, § 2468, additional. Title 12 of the Revised Statutes, as revised is amended by adding a new section 2468, to read as follows:

§ 2468. Fluorescent clothing

A person, while hunting with firearms in the Southwestern Deer Hunting Zone during the 1967 and 1968 deer hunting season, except when hunting waterfowl from a boat or blind, shall wear fluorescent, orange clothing which is visible at a  $360^{\circ}$  angle.
