AN ACT Revising Liquor Local Option Questions Two and Four.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- R. S., T. 28, § 101, sub-§§ 2, 4, amended. Subsections 2 and 4 of section 101 of Title 28 of the Revised Statutes are amended to read as follows:
- 2. Shall licenses be granted in this city or town for the sale herein of wine and, spirits and malt liquors to be consumed on the premises? (Hotel and Club)
- 4. Shall licenses be granted in this city or town for sale herein of malt liquor (beer, ale and other malt liquors) to be consumed on the premises? (Beer and Ale in Restaurants Hotels and Clubs)
