COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 362, L. D. 958, Bill, "An Act Relating to Transfer of State Prison First Offenders Under Age of Thirty-six to Reformatory for Men."

Amend said Bill by Striking out all of the first sentence of the 2nd paragraph (same in L. D. 958) and inserting in place thereof the following:

'The warden may from time to time, as he sees fit, recommend to a Board of Transfer set up within the department, and comprising the commissioner, the ~~Superintendent-of-the-Reformatory-for-Men, the Superintendent-of-the-Augusta-State-Hospital-and-the-Chairman-of-the State-Probation-and-Parele-Board,~~ warden, and the superintendent of the institutions involved, the transfer of ~~certain~~ any prison first offenders under age 36 from the State Prison to the Reformatory for Men when in his opinion such transfer is consistent with the best interest of the prisoner and the welfare of the public.'
