AN ACT to Increase the Salaries of Certain County Officers of Waldo County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 30, § 2, amended. The 15th paragraph of section 2 of Title 30 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by section 1 of chapter 397 of the public laws of 1965, which relates to Waldo County, is further amended to read as follows:
