IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED

AN ACT Prohibiting Shooting at or Near Wildfowl Decoys of Another.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 12, § 2466-A, additional. Title 12 of the Revised Statutes, as revised, is amended by adding a new section 2466-A, to read as follows:

§2466-A. Shooting at or near wildfowl decoys

Whoever, at any time, negligently or carelessly shoots at or near a wildfowl decoy or decoys of another, set on the territorial waters of this State, with a rifle, pistol or shotgun loaded with ball or buckshot is prima facie guilty of gross negligence, and shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$1,000 or by imprisonment of not more than 3 months.
