STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Security in Small Loan Transactions.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 9, § 3081, amended. Section 3081 of Title 9 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding at the end, 2 new sentences, as follows:

No licensee shall directly or indirectly accept or receive from any person any security agreement, mortgage or transfer of title in or to any property of the kinds eligible for exemptions under the laws of the State of Maine as security for the repayment of any loan of money, goods or choses in action wherein interest at a true rate in excess of 12% per year has been charged, contracted for or received. Any security agreement, mortgage or transfer of title directly or indirectly accepted or received in violation of this section shall be null and void and the contract of loan shall be unenforceable.
