**RESOLVE, Providing for Purchase of Fifty Copies of History of Bridgton,
Bicentennial Edition.**

History of Bridgton; appropriation for purchase of. Resolved. That there be appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$500 for the State to purchase 50 copies of the book entitled "History of Bridgton," said books to be exchanged or distributed at the discretion of the State Librarian.
