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**Advisory Committee on Education; appropriation. Resolved:** That there is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$4,350 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1968 and the sum of \$4,350 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1969 for secretarial and other expenses of the Advisory Committee on Education.
