SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 401, L. D. 1032, Bill, "An Act
Relating to Approval of Secondary Schools."

Amend said Bill by striking out everything after the
enacting clause and inserting in place thereof the following:

'R. S., T. 20, §1281, sub-§10 and 11, additional. Section
1281 of Title 20 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding
2 new subsections, to be numbered 10 and 11, to read as follows:

10. Size. Any public school enrolling fewer than 100
pupils may be approved by the State Board of Education on an
emergency basis only after the school committee or board of
directors has presented in detail reasons for such emergency
approval.

11. Private secondary schools. Notwithstanding this
section and sections 911 and 1344, students below the age of
17 years may attend private secondary schools which are not
authorized to accept state or local public funds, provided
that such schools are approved for this purpose by the State
Board of Education.'
