SENATE AMENDMENT "B" to S. P. 401, L. D. 1032, Bill, "An Act
Relating to Approval of Secondary Schools."

Amend said Bill by striking out everything after the
enacting clause and inserting in place thereof the following:

'R. S., T. 20, §1281, sub-§10, additional. Section 1281
of Title 20 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new
subsection 10, to read as follows:

10. Size. Any public school enrolling fewer than 100
pupils may be approved by the State Board of Education on an
emergency basis only after the school committee or board of
directors has presented in detail reasons for such emergency
approval.'
