AN ACT Relating to Approval of Secondary Schools.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 20, § 1281, sub-§ 10, additional. Section 1281 of Title 20 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new subsection 10, to read as follows:

10. Size. Any school enrolling fewer than 100 pupils may be approved by the State Board of Education on an emergency basis only after the school committee or board of directors has presented in detail reasons for such emergency approval. The board may approve private schools enrolling fewer than 100 pupils, but such schools shall not be approved for tuition purposes.
