SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 404, L. D. 1035, Bill, "An Act Relating to Forging Absentee Ballots or Applications Therefor under Election Laws."

Amend said Bill, in the Title, by inserting after the word "Forging" the words 'or Obtaining'

Further amend said Bill by inserting after the enacting clause the following:

'Sec. 1. R. S., T. 21, §1253, sub-§2, amended. The last sentence of subsection 2 of section 1253 of Title 21 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 8 of Chapter 451 of the public laws of 1965, is amended to read as follows:

'The clerk shall write in ink ~~ex-by-typewriter~~ the name of the person for whom the absentee ballot is intended in the upper left hand section of all return envelopes.'

Further amend said Bill by inserting at the beginning of the first line the underlined abbreviation and figure 'Sec. 2.'
