IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Emergency Admittance of Paupers to Hospitals.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 22, § 4452-A, additional. Title 22 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 4452-A, as follows:

§ 4452-A. Emergency admittance to hospitals

In the event of an emergency admittance to a hospital, as determined by said hospital, no town of settlement may deny liability for the medical bill of a pauper solely for the reason said pauper failed to receive authorization from the overseers of the poor prior to his admittance to said hospital.
