STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Transportation and Possession of Liquor by Minors.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 28, § 303, amended. Section 303 of Title 28 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding at the end the following sentence:

If a minor is charged with illegal possession under this section he may not be charged with illegal transportation.

Sec. 2. R. S., T. 28, § 1001, amended. Section 1001 of Title 28 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding at the end the following new paragraphs:

If a minor is charged with illegal transportation under this section he may not be charged with illegal possession.

No person under the age of 21 years shall have a container of intoxicating liquor that has been opened within the passenger section of a motor vehicle under his control.

No person under the age of 21 years shall be convicted of any offense under this section if intoxicating liquors are found outside the passenger section of a motor vehicle under his control unless said person has knowledge of the presence of said liquors.
