IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Increasing Salary of Forest Commissioner.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 12, § 501, amended. The last sentence of section 501 of Title 12 of the Revised Statutes, as repealed and replaced by section 20 of chapter 513 of the public laws of 1965, is amended to read as follows:

He (Forest Commissioner) shall receive an annual base salary of \$13,000 \$16,000, of which \$8,667 \$10,667 shall be paid from funds raised and created by the tax assessed under section 1601.

Sec. 2. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Fund the sum of \$889 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1968 and the sum \$1,100 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1969 to carry out the purposes of this Act.
