# IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-SEVEN

### AN ACT Relating to Automobile Mileage Allowable to County Commissioners.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 30, § 2, amended. The next to the last paragraph of section 2 of Title 30 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding at the end, a new sentence, as follows:

The county shall pay for use of privately-owned automobiles for travel by a county commissioner in the business of the county, including travel from residence of commissioner to office of county commissioners at the county courthouse, at not more than 10c a mile.
