STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Increasing Fees for Recording Deeds and Tax Liens.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 33, § 751, sub-§ 1, amended. Subsection 1 of section 751 of Title 33 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by chapter 265 of the public laws of 1965, is further amended to read as follows:

1. Deed or mortgage. Recording a deed or mortgage that fits the printed form currently in use in the registry, \$3 \$5.

Sec. 2. R. S., T. 33, § 751, sub-§ 11, amended. Subsection 11 of Section 751 of Title 33 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

11. Municipal tax liens. Recording a municipal tax lien in accordance with Title 36, section 942, \$= \$3.

Sec. 3. R. S., T. 33, § 751, sub-§ 12, amended. Subsection 12 of section 751 of Title 33 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by chapter 265 of the public laws of 1965, is further amended to read as follows:

12. Instruments that will not fit printed form. Receiving, recording and indexing any deed or mortgage that is not on a regular form, or any other instrument entitled to be recorded the charge shall be \$3 \$5 for the first page and \$1 per page for each additional record page or fraction thereof.
