STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
SIXTY-SEVEN

RESOLVE, to Reimburse Elmer Hannigan of Portland for Property Damage by Highway Construction.

Elmer Hannigan; reimbursed. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the General Highway Fund to Elmer Hannigan of Portland the sum of \$1,425 for damage to his property on Washington Avenue in Portland by construction of highway.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Although no land was taken by the construction of the highway, changes in grade adjacent to the property has definitely affected the market value of Mr. Hannigan's property. Considerable water has been found in the cellar along the southerly basement wall. In order to eliminate this water condition, the slope at the rear of the building should be black topped and a black topped gutter or trench should be built parallel to the rear foundation wall and connected to a catch basin. The catch basin should be installed southerly from the concrete sidewalk.
