COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 735, L.D. 1058, Resolve, to

Resolved: That there is appropriated from the Dog Tax Account
the sum of \$82.50 to reimburse Wayne Smith of East Dixfield as a
full and final settlement of his claim against the State for loss
of sheep killed by bears.'
