### STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-SEVEN

RESOLVE, to Reimburse Wayne Smith of East Dixfield for Loss of Sheep.

Wayne Smith; reimbursed. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$100 to reimburse Wayne Smith of East Dixfield as a full and final settlement of his claim against the State for loss of sheep killed by bears.

#### STATEMENT OF FACTS

In June 1964, Mr. Smith had several sheep killed by bears. Since the carcasses were not found, he was not reimbursed by the Department of Agriculture.
