STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Preschool Physical Examinations of Children.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 20, c. 109, sub-c. III-A, additional. Chapter 109 of Title 20 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new subchapter III-A, to read as follows:

SUBCHAPTER III-A PHYSICAL EXAMINATIONS

§ 1101. Physical examinations

Every child on reaching his 5th birthday shall obtain a physical examination by his family physician. If such examination reveals that the child has not been immunized against pertussis, diphtheria, tetanus, smallpox, polio or measles, such immunization shall be done at this time. The family physician shall record the information on forms developed by the Department of Health and Welfare and shall become a part of the school record of such child. Any defects noted may be corrected. Any expenses incurred under this section shall be borne by the parents or legal guardian of such child and if such child is medically indigent such expenses shall be paid for by the Department of Health and Welfare.
