RESOLVE, Designating Certain Highways in Lincoln County as Mariner and Pioneer Trail.

Certain highways in Lincoln County designating Mariner and Pioneer Trail.
Resolved: That the following highway route in Lincoln County be designated as Mariner and Pioneer Trail: Beginning at Pemaquid Point Light and following highway routes 130, 32, 213, 215, business route 1 to route 130 or 129 alternate or both, and returning to route 130 and alternate to Pemaquid Beach, and returning to point of beginning by route 130; and be it further

Resolved: That the State Highway Commission shall erect along said highways suitable tablets and signs designating such trail.
