STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Appropriating Funds for Fort Fairfield Municipal Park.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Fort Fairfield Municipal Park; appropriation. There is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$9,000 to the Town of Fort Fairfield for the purpose of constructing and establishing a municipal park in the Town of Fort Fairfield in the vicinity of the library, swimming pool, armory and school building complex. The Town of Fort Fairfield is authorized to accept from any source, federal, state or local, further funds to aid in accomplishing the purposes of this Act.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Fort Fairfield is unique in that its new high school, its junior high school, its state armory, its swimming pool, ice skating rink and public library all lie near each other. The funds requested would, together with substantial federal, state and local participation, permit Fort Fairfield to establish a municipal park encompassing the above areas that would have substantial recreational and municipal advantages.
