STATEMENT OF FACTS

On September 26, 1966, at approximately 4:45 p.m., the State Police from the barracks in Skowhegan, Maine, telephoned Fairview Hospital stating that a man with a gunshot wound was being brought to the hospital. At the insistence of the State Police, the hospital accepted the patient, Mr. John Rastrom, and provided all treatment and service necessary for the patient's welfare without regard to the expense incurred.

At the time Mr. Rastrom was admitted, he was under arrest and in the custody of the State Police.

During the time which Mr. Rastrom spent in the hospital, he was under constant guard. He was discharged November 29, 1966.
