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**AN ACT Relating to Powers of Attorneys in Taking Acknowledgements for  
Instruments for Recording.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., T. 4, § 1056, additional.** Title 4 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 1056, to read as follows:

**§ 1056. Powers of attorneys**

Attorneys at law duly admitted to practice in the courts of the State shall have all of the powers of justices of the peace and notaries public in the taking of acknowledgements to deeds and other documents requiring acknowledgement for record.
