AN ACT Concerning Duty of Reasonable Care to Social Invitee.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

R. S., T. 14, § 159, additional. Title 14 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 159, to read as follows :

§ 159. Social and business visitors, standards of care

No distinction shall be made in law between a social visitor and a business visitor as to the standard of care which may be owed to them upon any premises.

STATEMENT OF PURPOSE

To give the same protection to a person invited for occupiers' pleasure as for one who is invited for his business.
