STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Increasing Salaries of Members of Industrial Accident Commission.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 39, § 91, amended. The first sentence of the 3rd paragraph of section 91 of Title 39 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by section 1 of chapter 417 of the public laws of 1965, is further amended to read as follows:

The chairman (of the Industrial Accident Commission) shall receive a salary of \$11,500 \$13,500 per year, and the other commissioners a salary of \$10,000 each per year.

Sec. 2. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Industrial Accident Commission the sum of \$6,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1968 and the sum of \$8,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1969 to carry out the purposes of this Act.
