RESOLVE, Granting World War I Bonus to Charles Girofalo.

Charles Girofalo; appropriation for World War I bonus. Resolved: There is appropriated from the General Fund the sum of \$100 to be paid to Charles Girofalo of Everett, Massachusetts, as his World War I bonus.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Mr. Girofalo has never received his World War I bonus. He entered the service in Bangor and was honorably discharged.
