SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 747, L. D. 1094, Bill, "An Act
Relating to Special Offices for Indian Tribes."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the first
paragraph of that part designated "§4705" and inserting in
place thereof the following:

'The tribal governor of each reservation, with the advice
and consent of the tribal council of each such reservation, may
appoint persons to the positions of tribal custodian and tribal
maintenanceman.'
