## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Degree of Blood of Penobscot Indians for Purposes of State Law.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- R. S., T. 22, § 4761, sub-§ 4, additional. Section 4761 of Title 22 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new subsection 4, to read as follows:
- 4. Degree of blood. For the purposes of State laws pertaining to Indians, it shall be considered that any Penobscot Indian born prior to January 1, 1901 shall be considered to be, or to have been, a full-blooded Penobscot Indian.
