AN ACT Relating to Chiropractic Services for Injured Employee Under Workmen's Compensation Law.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 39, § 52, amended. The first sentence of section 52 of Title 39 of the Revised Statutes, as repealed and replaced by section 1 of chapter 408 and as amended by section 4 of chapter 489, both of the public laws of 1965, is further amended to read as follows:

An employee sustaining a personal injury by accident arising out of and in the course of his employment shall be entitled to reasonable and proper medical, surgical and hospital services, nursing, medicines, and mechanical, surgical aids, as needed, paid for by the employer; **and such employee shall be entitled to chiropractic services, as needed, paid for by the employer, provided that the commission finds such services to be reasonable and proper.**
