AN ACT Increasing Compensation of State Personnel Board.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 5, § 591, amended. The 6th sentence of section 591 of Title 5 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

The public members of the board shall receive ~~\$10~~ \$25 a day for the time actually spent in the discharge of their duties, and their necessary expenses.

Sec. 2. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the State Personnel Board the sum of \$600 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1968 and \$800 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1969 to carry out the purposes of this Act. The breakdown shall be as follows:
