AN ACT Relating to Nonlapsing Funds for Land in Town of Wells for Park
Purposes.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1965, c. 161, Section B, amended. That part of Section B of chapter 161 of the private and special laws of 1965, under the caption "STATE PARKS AND RECREATION COMMISSION", which relates to acquisition of land in Wells is amended to read as follows:

* Wells \$125,500 —

* Any balance of the above starred appropriation shall not lapse and any unexpended and unencumbered balances after acquisition of the land may be used towards development of the project.
